ELIGIBILITY

The applicant **must be** a high school senior and a **resident** of **Farmington** or **West Hartford**. Each year, up to three scholarships are awarded. <u>All requested materials must accompany this application</u>. The committee's decision, in conjunction with the Hartford Foundation for Public Giving, and the amount awarded is final.

This scholarship is awarded to anyone regardless of race, creed or national origin. A personal interview with the scholarship committee is required. Children of chapter members are <u>not</u> eligible.

NOTE: SCHOLARSHIP EXTENSION PROGRAM

The recipients of this Farmington UNICO scholarship may apply for the **Aldo DeDominics Scholarship** at the conclusion of their freshmen year. Reapplication is required for each of the subsequent three years and an award of \$1,200 or more each year may be made. This award is processed by the Hartford Foundation for Public Giving and the Farmington UNICO Scholarship committee.
